About the 27th Toyota Youth Orchestra Camp (TYOC)

One of the main annual events organized by The Federation of Japan Amateur Orchestras (JAO) is the Toyota Youth Orchestra Camp. We have been improving the contents every year and we take pride in achieving every time a better version of the camp. Since its beginning in 1985, TYOC has attracted more than 4,850 participants, most of whom were in their 40's and were members of amateur orchestras. Improving the skills of youth from all over the country as performers and managers

Staging public rehearsals and concerts at the place where the event takes place.

Offering to local youth an opportunity to study with top-notch coaches and conductor

Offering opportunities to youth from all over Asia to participate in TYOC.

1 .「Toyota Youth Orchestra Camp」 Purpose

The Toyota Orchestra Camp was created through the initiative of The Federation of Japan Amateur Orchestras and the support of Toyota Motor Corporation. The objective of the project is to foster musical education and give a chance to young performers to hone their skills under the guidance of experienced artists and teachers. That project started in 1985 and is now headed towards its 27th edition. The camp offers opportunity for youth interested in orchestral playing to get their guidance from top-notch professionals in the field of music but also in the field of orchestra management. As these camps are organized in different places every year their purpose is to leave behind, at the local level, youngsters who will be able not only to play but also to manage local orchestras. To attend the camp will also provide a rare opportunity to make friends and establish relations for the future through attending seminars, rehearsals, lectures and ultimately perform together at concerts. The curriculum is based on two years attendance units and the second year is when the results of the training are gleaned at a special concert. In order to promote development of those activities at the local level a separate program: The Toyota Music Friends Gathering. Program has also been established.

3 . How to register .

Participant qualification	<p>In principle from age 13 (J.H.S 1) to 23 in March 2011. Any of the conditions listed below To have the intention to attend the 28th TYOC to be held between March 28 and March 31 in Toyohashi in 2012. < J A O Member > If the candidate is a JAO member, to bring a recommendation letter from the head of his/her local organization < General public > ...Please contact JAO office for detailed information. Support the objectives of TYOC and get the sponsors' approval (for those belonging to non-member orchestras or to school orchestras, for instance)</p>
Participation Fees	<p>27,000 Yen (This amount varies every year according to the venue.) [This covers the use of rehearsal spaces, food, accommodations and local transport.] However transportation to and from Toyohashi is the participants responsibility. For participants coming from more than 500 km. away from the Toyohashi JR station, the participation fee will be reduced to 22,000 Yen. Participation fees should be paid through a bank deposit. The account numbers will be sent together with the participation approval document at a later date.</p>
Quotas and participant approval	<p>160 participants In case the applicants number exceed the capacity of the orchestra applications may be rejected. That decision will be made by the JAO Youth Orchestra Committee and will be announced at the end of December 2010. As ample participation in TYOC is desirable and in case the applicant's number exceed the manageable capacity selection will be based on dividing slots equitably between new and older participants.</p>

Limit date for sending applications	<u>Wednesday, November 10, 2010</u>
Important remarks	<p>(1) The application limit date will be strictly applied (2) The applicant will clearly detail the part he/she intends to play That is, not only strings or wind instruments but what part. (Ex: 1st Vn. 2nd Vn, Fl, 1 or 2 and so forth. In case special instruments are required give as much details as you can. (3) Regarding the part that you wish to play you must consult with your teacher before writing in on the application form. (4) Do not omit to write down a brief resume as well as your hopes for the future because this will bear on the selection process. (5) One photograph (35mm×30mm) to be pasted on your application form. (6) Have the recommendation letter signed in the proper place by the person who wrote it. (7) Regarding the schedule, the guide maps to the venue, the meeting places and the participation fees, detailed information will be provided at a later date. (8) According to the limitation of the number of participants some candidate's application may be rejected but this does not apply to part leaders or those participating in management programs. (9) In case of cancellation or changes in the information provided on the application form consult your coach first and then send the changes by fax or mail to the JAO Office. Telephone calls will not be accepted. <u>In case the cancellation is received with less than two days anticipation, participation fees will not be returned.</u></p>
