· Vocal Painting Workshop

Basak Dogan was the first Turkish person to enroll in the Royal Danish Academy of Music, where she learned new choral conducting and improvisational techniques originating in Scandinavia. This method involves allowing each performer to express their own rhythm and music improvisationally, creating a choir through 74 signs (gestures = conducting).


